PBL @ WPS



At Wellington Public School good discipline and effective learning rely on the positive partnerships between teachers, parents, carers and students.

Using the framework of **Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL)** WPS has developed a proactive school-wide approach for supporting appropriate student behaviour to create a positive school environment.


At WPS we have 3 expectations in all areas of school life.

- Be a learner
- Be respectful
- Be safe

Academic and social outcomes for all students are enhanced by putting in place sustainable school-wide, classroom and individual systems of support. Decisions are made in response to data analysis and evidence based practices are established to support student learning and behaviour.

The three tiered continuum approach focuses on universal interventions for all students, targeted interventions for some at-risk students and intensive, individual interventions for a few students.





These are the WPS bee logos based on our school wide expectations. Our bees also have names associated with the expectations. These are: Lenny Learner, Reggie Respectful and Sammy Safe.



Buzzies

Buzzies are the basis for our rewards program. Students earn buzzies by demonstrating the positive behaviours they have learnt. At WPS these positive behaviours include being Respectful, Safe and a Learner. Each Monday at the whole school assembly 3 students from each stage are drawn out to receive either a lucky dip prize or canteen vouchers/free time card.

Buzzie Patrol

Junior and Senior SRC students are allocated one duty per week to hand out 4 'Buzzies' to students doing the right thing in the playground. Buzzie Patrol students wear bright orange vests so that they are able to be seen by all students in the playground. Each Buzzie Patrol student will hand out 4 'Buzzies' and will be supervised by the teacher on duty to ensure they are handing out 'Buzzies' correctly and fairly to students doing the expected behaviour for that particular week.

Buzzie Patrol allows SRC students to gain a sense of responsibility within the playground and allows them to gain respect from their fellow peers. Buzzie Patrol aims to make WPS students more aware of their behaviour whilst in the playground and gain positive rewards through doing so.

Buzzie Barometer

The WPS Buzzie Barometer is a whole school rewards system. At each Monday whole school assembly all Buzzies that are not drawn out as weekly winners will go into the Buzzie Barometer. An interactive dice is rolled on the overhead screen and student selected rewards are on each side of the dice. The dice is rolled before the barometer is full, so students know what reward they are working toward. When the barometer is full students receive the reward rolled. Rewards include: free icy cup day, casual clothes day, 5 minutes extra playtime at lunch. Allowing students to witness the Buzzie Barometer filling up is an incentive for students to earn Buzzies through good behaviour.
