Here is the 18th instalment of parenting tips incorporated from the positive parenting program and brought to you by the Barnardos Family Strengthening Project.

Planned Ignoring

The technique of planned ignoring is deliberately not paying attention to a child when a minor problem behaviour happens such as whining, making faces, using a silly voice or making rude noises. If these minor problems are ignored, children learn that they no longer get a reaction when they behave this way. As soon as the problem behaviour stops and your child behaves well, praise them and give them your attention.
