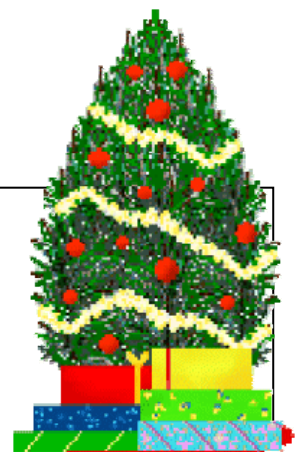
If you missed out on any of the items from the celebrations, especially our book, there are still some available for purchase at the office.
