Although teachers will be at school on Friday 27th January all students are to return on Monday including Kindergarten.

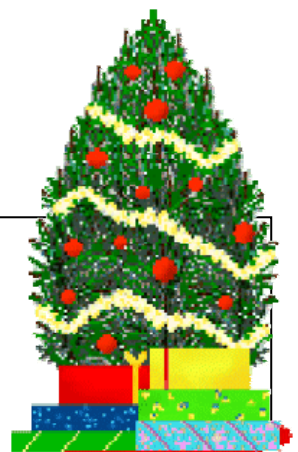

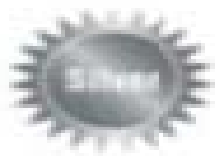

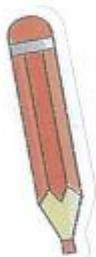
