# Maps

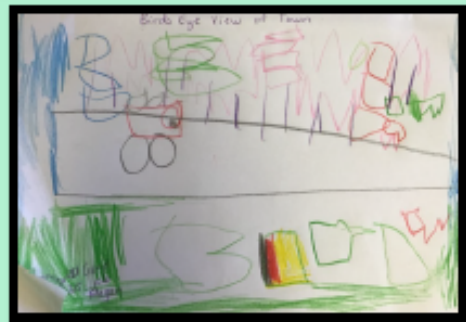
with Kindergarten Green
