Good luck to all our runners at the District Cross Country tomorrow. There will also be Girls Softball and Boys Soccer on Friday.

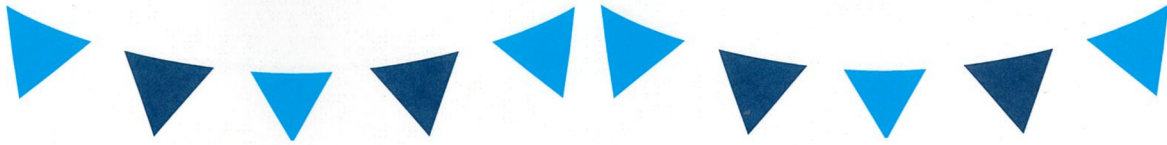
