Her role models are her Mum and Kaldence.











#### What is it?

If you would like to participate you can create a shoebox diorama of a scene from the book. Bring your entry to school on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2022 and place it in the Gould League Hall. We will then vote for our favourite box and the winners will receive a book fair youcher!

#### The details

- Use a shoebox or a similar sized box, lay it on its side to create your scene.
- Use small objects such as toys, paper, playdoh, plants, stones and cardboard to create your scene. Decorate all the inside walls of your box.
- The title and author of the book should be displayed somewhere on the outside of the box.
- Put your name and class on the bottom of the box so it can't be seen when we are voting – we want to vote anonymously.

#### Tips for success!

- ✓ Keep it simple so people can recognise the book
- ✓ Include details in your scene to make it look more realistic.
- ✓ Keep your box small like a shoebox.
