

- All works should have Title & Artist's details clearly & securely attached to the back.
- All works can be delivered to the Western Gallery from Thursday 04.07.2024 to Saturday 06.07.2024 between 10am – 2pm. If you are unable to make the drop off during these times, please contact WACI via email to arrange an appropriate time.
- Insurance of all works is the responsibility of the artist.
- Please state on your entry form sale price of works (or NFS). WACI charges a commission of 30% for all works sold during the exhibition, please add the commission to total price. EXAMPLE: If you are selling your artwork for \$100.00, \$30.00 of the amount will be commission and \$70.00 will be paid to the artist. When pricing your artwork please add the commission to the total amount of the sales price.
- Prize money will be paid within two weeks following the end of the exhibition.
 WACI will contact you for your bank details.
- Payment of sold works will be made to artists within four weeks following the end of the exhibition.
 WACI will contact you for your bank details.
- Wellington Arts reserves the right to refuse any works deemed inappropriate.
- The committee and judge's decision are final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
