### Moving into Year 7 in a NSW Government school 2025



Apply online to start the transition of your child from Year 6 to Year 7

#### Your child's local school

Most NSW Government schools have designated intake areas so that all school-age children will be eligible to atten'l'I a government high school -their local school.

Your child's permanent residential address determines which school is your child's local school. The School Finder tool at https://schoolfinder.education.nsw.gov.au/ can help you locate the local school.

Most parents and carers in NSW choose their local high school to provide an education of excellence for their child. The department's online enrolment system supports the transition to high school. THE DEPARTMENT HAS DIGITISED THE YEAR 6 TO YEAR 7 TRANSITION PROCESS. Parents and carers should go online to complete the EXPRESSION of INTEREST (EOI). Go to the Wellington Public School website click the ENROLMENT tab, scroll down to 'Moving to high school' click it and follow the process. This is OPEN from 6th MARCH 2024.
