## FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Well, one week of Term remaining.

Yet another busy week.

Thanks so much to Mrs Fitzsimmons and Ms Stone for ensuring that 165 students received their Books in Homes packages yesterday. A kind generation for Northbridge Rotary and support from the Rotary Club of Wellington made this all possible. Thank you!

We are finishing the Term with great attendance numbers across the school. All years this week were again above 90% which is tremendous and well above the State level of attendance expected of our students.

We have finalised our policy for funding excursions and other activities.

An activity up to \$100 per student, the school will cover 25% of the total cost. How to apply - Parents contact the school to request funding with reasoning to support the application. School will meet these costs. If demand is high (more than 20 students per activity) the school may approach the P&C for additional support.

An activity up to \$100 to \$500 per student, the school will cover 50% of the total cost. How to apply - Parents contact the school to request funding with reasoning to support the application. P&C will support students. If demand is high (more than 20 students per activity) the school may work with the P&C for the additional support.

More than \$500 per student, 50% of total cost. May be supported by:

- Special item for sale at the canteen – money raised to go towards subsidising the group cost
- Class to explore fundraising activities such as a zooper dooper stall
  - Hosting a social with a gold coin donation as entry

How to apply - Parents contact the school to request funding with reasoning to support the application. P&C will support the activity. If demand is high (class, stage or school activities) the school will work with the P&C to support the activity.

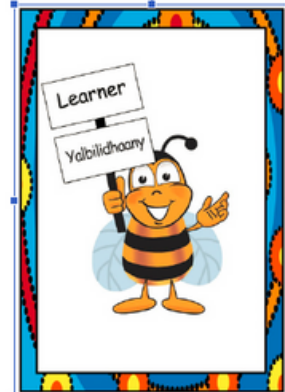
### ABOUT SHARON AND HER TIME AT WPS.


