Buy a Birthday Bucket from the WPS Canteen to celebrate your child's birthday with their class.








Let the canteen staff know what your child would like to fill their bucket with to share with their class. You pay for the contents of the bucket and then the bucket gets returned to the canteen.

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




Introducing Beanstack

Beanstack is a web-based reading challenge software. This winter, Macquarie Regional Library members of all ages are invited to sign up for the Winter Reading Challenge on Beanstack, and log their reading for the chance to win some fantastic prizes.

Create an account

- Download the "Beanstack Tracker" app from your device's app store and search for MACQUARIE REGIONAL LIBRARY, or go to our Beanstack website: macquarielibrary.beanstack.org
- Click on "Register an Individual or Family."
- Fill in your info! Beanstack allows families to be linked together, so all family members can be accessed with one login.

Add a reader

- In the app, select the gear icon in the upper right-hand corner of the screen, click "Readers" then "Add A Reader." On the website, select the current user's name in the upper right-hand corner of the screen, then "Add A Reader."
- 2. Fill in your reader's information, click "Continue" and register for the "Winter Reading Challenge." You will receive a virtual badge as confirmation that your reader has registered for the Winter Reading Challenge.

Log your reading

 Click the "Log Reading" button in the upper left corner of the site, or click on the blue plus sign (+) in the app.

Prize draw

- Upon registering for the Winter Reading Challenge, and for every 20 minutes
 of reading logged, you will receive a virtual badge. Each badge earns one entry
 into the prize draw.
- You can view how many badges you have under the "Badges" tab.
- Prizes are drawn weekly and Macquarie Regional Library will contact the winners. All badges will roll over into the next draw, so keep logging your reading to increase your chances of winning!

Online Parenting Group

Online parenting groups are for parents & carers who would like to:

- Understand their child's emotional world by learning to read their emotional needs
- Support their child's ability to successfully manage emotions
- Improve communication and strengthen the bond with their child
- Better understand their child's behaviour and learn new parenting approaches



We are offering two programs: Circle of Security and Tuning in to Kids. What is Circle of Security®?

The Circle of Security (CoS) Parenting™ program is based on decades of research about how secure parent-child relationships can be supported and strengthened. It is best suited for parents/carers of children aged 1-5 yrs although can be beneficial for all parents/carers.

What is Tuning in to Kids®?

Tuning in to Kids (TIK) is an evidenced based, emotion-focused parenting course that supports Parents & carers to recognise, understand and manage their own and their children's emotions. It is best suited for parents/carers of children aged 3-12 yrs.

Who is it for?

We are delivering TIK & CoS as part of our Community Recovery Service which covers the following LGAs in NSW: **Cabonne**,

Cootamundra-Gundagai, Dubbo, Forbes, Gunnedah, Snowy Valleys, Glen Ines, Severn and Snowy Monaro.

Where?

Groups will take place online via Zoom. Access to stable internet, a computer/device, and a private space will be required.
